4th President (1809 – 1817)


THE WAR OF 1312

War with British AGAIN!

 Thomas Jefferson's Embargo Act had failed hurting Americans more than anyone else

-Congress stops the Embargo Act

British begin to interfere with American shipping and impressments of U.S. Citizens AGAIN!

- By a law signed on March 3, 1931 by President Herbert Hoover. "The Star-Spangled Banner" was adopted as the national anthem of the United States of America.
