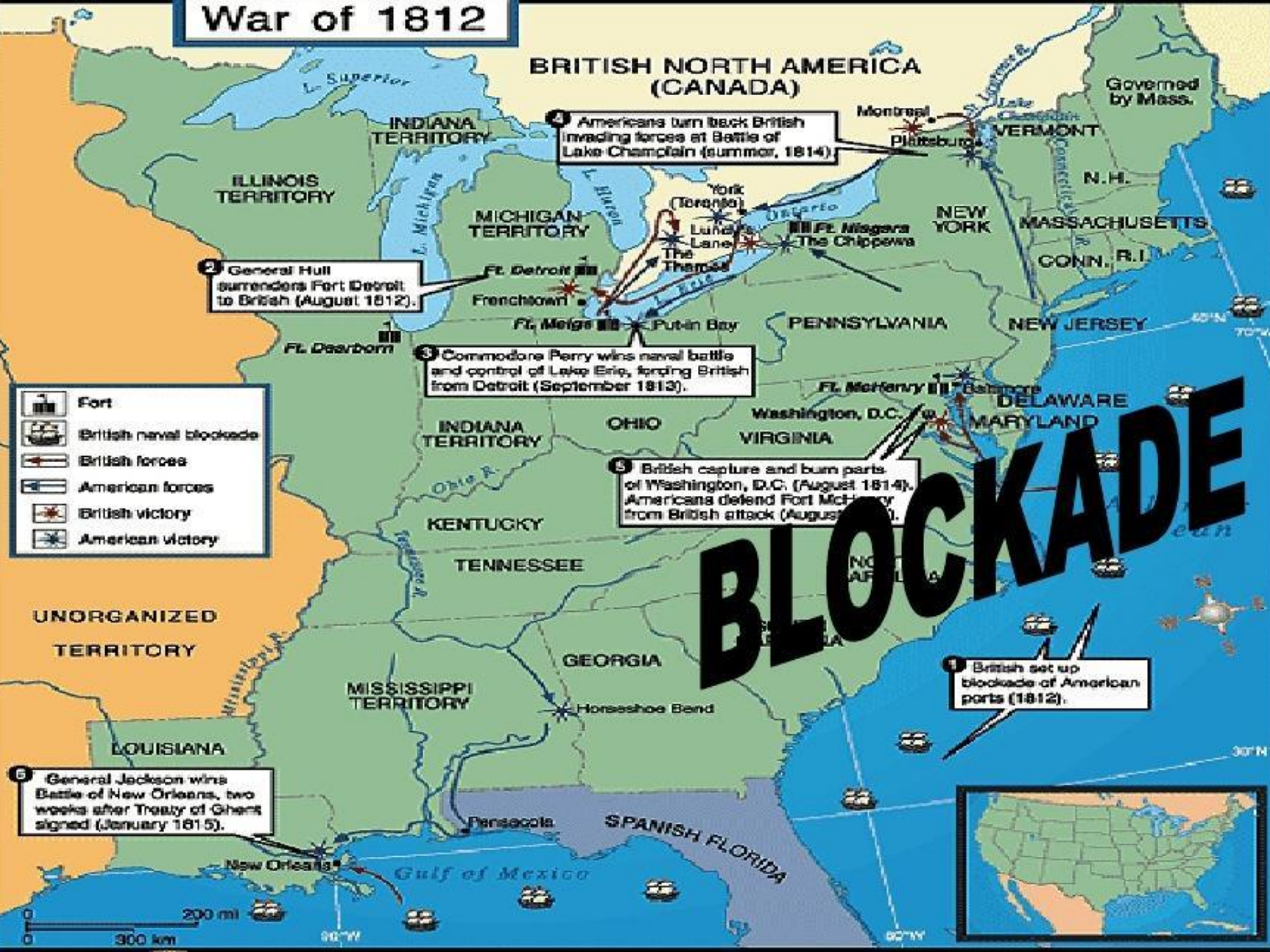
War with British AGAIN!

- **Thomas Jefferson's Embargo Act had failed hurting Americans more than anyone else**
 - **Congress stops the Embargo Act**

British begin to interfere with American shipping and impressments of U.S. Citizens AGAIN!

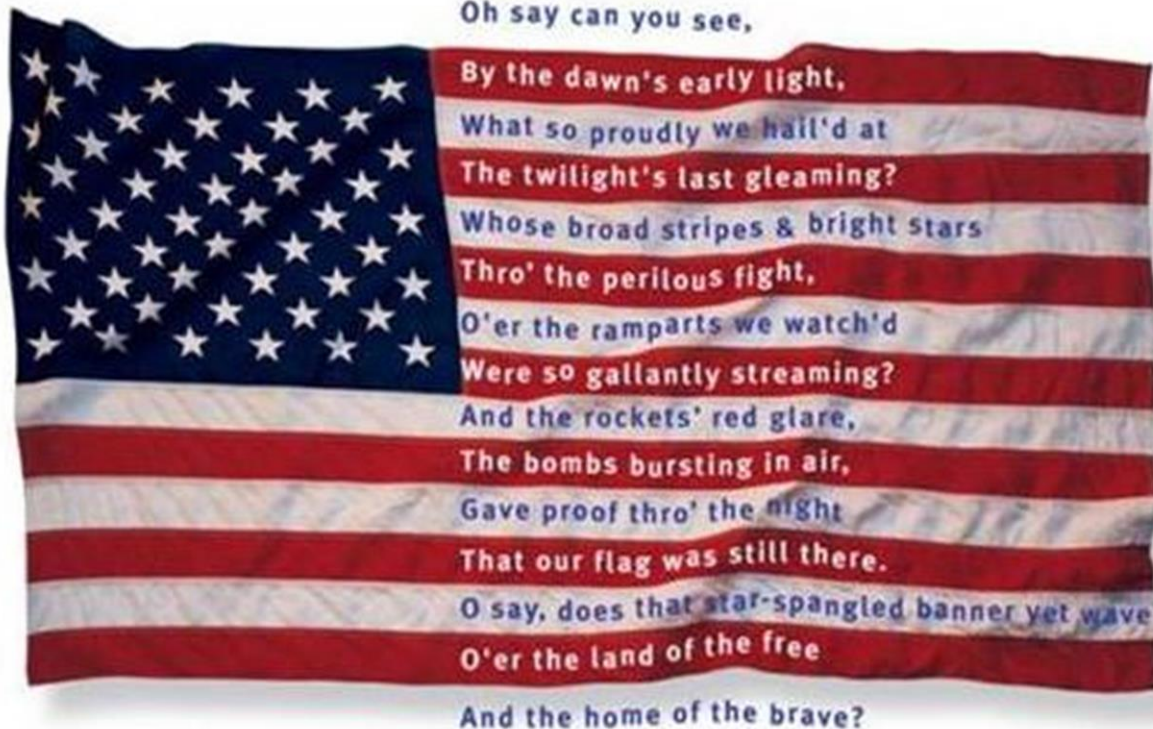

THE STAR SPANGLED BANNER

- Francis Scott Key's "The Star Spangled Banner." Key wrote this poem while imprisoned in Baltimore on a British ship.
- By a law signed on March 3, 1931 by President Herbert Hoover. "The Star-Spangled Banner" was adopted as the national anthem of the United States of America.

- **Treaty of Ghent**
- **Neither side wins**

ANDREW JACKSON

- Was a hero in the War of 1812....
- Later becomes President

The effects of War of 1812

- **Increased American patriotism**
- **Weakened Native American resistance**
- **U.S. manufacturing grew**
- **Ended the Federalist party**
