Minimal

mínima

- the least possible; very small or slight

Intrusion

intrusión

- Disturbance; unlawful entry

Free Enterprise

libre empresa

- A system in which private businesses are able to compete with each other with little control by the government

Consumer *mínima*

- a person who buys goods and services

Remedy *remedio*

- a way of solving or correcting a problem

Amend *enmendar*

- to change some of the words and often the meaning of (a law, document, etc.)

Impose *remedio*

- to establish or create (something unwanted) in a forceful way

Excise

- a tax on certain things that are made, sold, or used within a country

federal

- relating to a form of government in which power is shared between a central government and individual states

Advocate

defensor

- one that supports or promotes the interests of another

Excerpt

extracto

- to include (part of a longer written work) in something else

Seizure

embargar

- the act of taking control of something by force

Probable

probable

- likely to happen or to be true but not certain

Civic Virtue

virtud
cívica

- the cultivation of habits of personal living that are claimed to be important for the success of the community

Ratify

ratificar

- to make (a treaty, agreement, etc.) official by signing it or voting for it

Endowed

dotado

- to give a large amount of money to a school, hospital, etc., in order to pay for the creation or continuing support of (something)

Preserve

preservación

- to keep (something) in its original state or in good condition

Persecution persecución

- the act or practice of being harassed, or annoyed; especially those who differ in origin, religion, or social outlook

Amendment enmienda

- a change in the words or meaning of a law or document (such as a constitution)

Representation representación

- a person or group that speaks or acts for or in support of another person or group

Oppose oponerse

- to disagree with or disapprove of (something or someone)
